PETS

All dogs, cats, and other meat-eating animals must spend time in animal quarantine when they enter Hawaii. This quarantine is required to confirm that the animals do not have rabies. Animals may spend their quarantine period on Kauai at the Kauai Humane Society facility. You must make arrangements before arriving. Your current veterinarian must prepare a pre-shipment health certificate, and you must make appropriate arrangements for shipment, particularly if you will not be accompanying the pet.

Your pet will be required to stay two days on Oahu before being sent to Kauai by plane at your expense. Depending on the degree to which you prepare your pet with immunizations, the pet will remain in quarantine for either 30 days or 120 days.

If you can plan four months in advance and prearrange all the necessary paperwork, you may qualify for a 5-day quarantine or you may qualify for a "walk through," which allows your pet to leave the quarantine facility with you.

Quarantine charges vary. Other charges may apply for food, treatment, or grooming. Regulations and procedures are complicated, so call or have your vet call in advance.

BY AIR—For air freight of small shipments, companies that receive and deliver air shipments include DHL, Aloha Airlines, Hawaiian Airlines, United Airlines, and Savage & Sweet Air Freight. The U.S. Postal Service, Federal Express, and UPS also provide express delivery services.

ON LAND—Bulk freight is delivered by Kauai Commercial Co., 245-1985, Kauai Freight Service, 245-1919, Kauai Veterans Express, 245-3553. Other trucking companies are available.

SHOPPING

Shopping on Kauai is as laid back as the island itself. Kukui Grove in Lihue is the only major mall. Major mainland stores include Macy's, Wal-Mart, Sears, Kmart and Home Depot. Kauai has a number of smaller shopping centers: Coconut Marketplace and Kauai Village in Kapaa, Poipu Shopping Village and Old Koloa Town on the South Shore and Ching Young Village in Hanalei. In these smaller shopping centers, you'll discover many treasures such as island-style clothing, hand-made jewelry, Hawaiian quilts, and an array of fine art, from paintings and sculptures to ceramics and photography. When browsing, be on the lookout for unique Kauai-made products, including hand-carved koa bowls and boxes, and shirts that are dyed using Kauai's rust-red soil.

Grocery stores include Papaya's Natural Foods Market, Foodland, Safeway, Big Save, Kojima's and Star Market.

SUNSHINE MARKETS

Every new resident should check out the local sunshine markets as soon as possible — a great way to get the best locally grown fruits and vegetables direct from the grower. Visiting the sunshine markets also provides an

TRANSPORTATION
