Lihue - Princeville-30 miles/48 km.

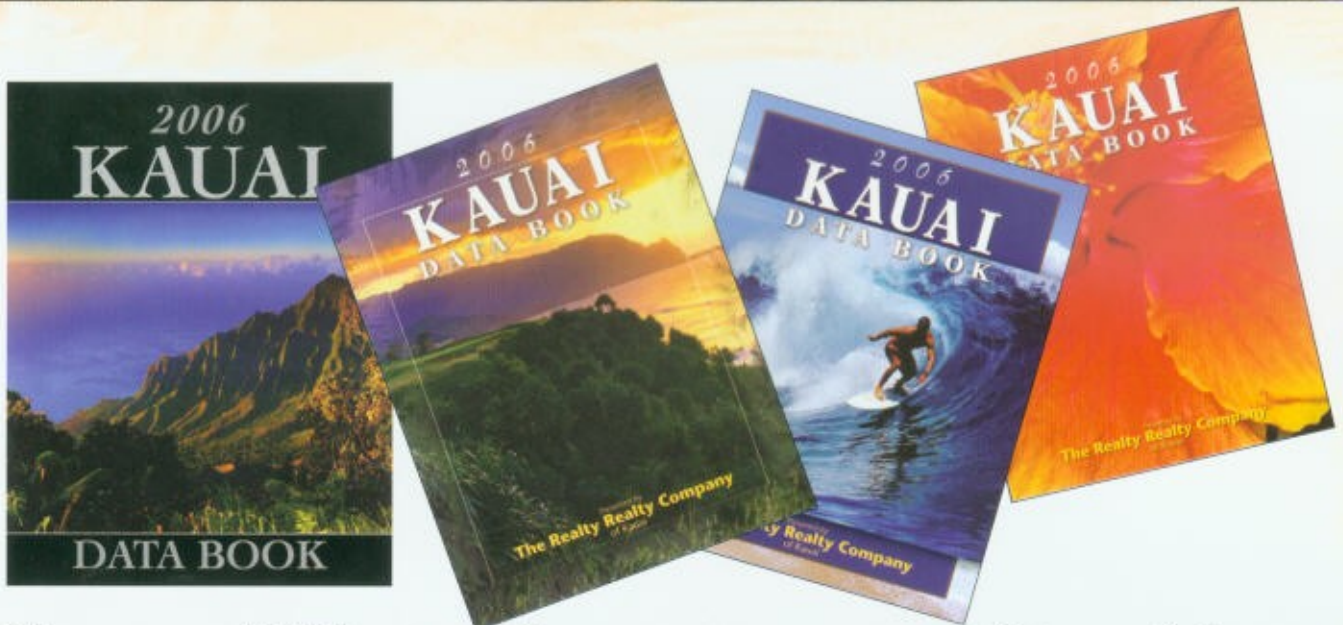
## Significant Waterfalls

Hinalele (Wainiha Valley) 280 feet  
Kapaka Nui (Makaleha Mountains) 280 feet

**Highest Peak:** Kawaikini Peak  
("The Multitudinous Water") 5,243 feet

**Landmark Peak:** Waialeale Peak  
("Rippling Water") 5,148 feet
